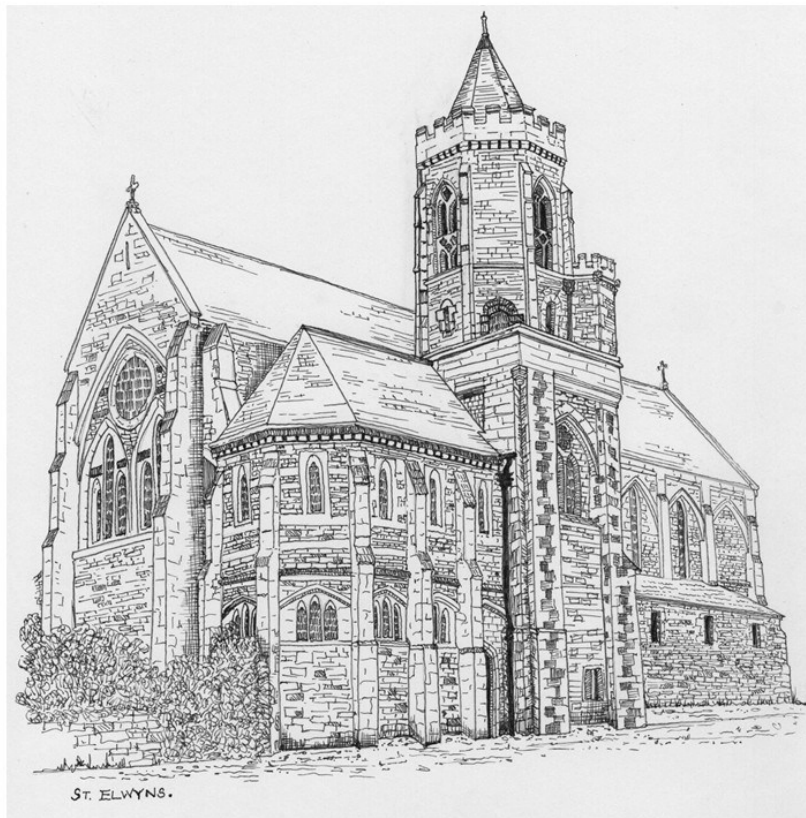

A St Erth resident spotted this item and was keen to save it for posterity. He organised a mini group funding and the clock was purchased. It will be placed on permanent loan to Hayle Heritage Centre and can be seen when the Centre reopens next summer when the renovations are complete.

An 8 day oak long case clock made by Roger Wearn of St Erth in about 1780 with high tide at Hayle calibrations has returned home.

The late Nigel Trevelyan who died in May this year was a local auctioneer and antiques expert who had amassed a collection of 21 Cornish long case clocks.

They came up for auction at Plymouth recently.

There is a similar Wearn clock in the Truro museum and on St Michael's Mount.
